

# Bike/Ped Committee

## Jan. 17, 2018

The meeting began at 7:30 AM

The following items were discussed:

1. Paul Niehoff—gave update of Eastern Trail after Carol Brush presented at last meeting. Continued efforts to privately fund raise for the 1.6-mile connector from SP to Scarborough over the marsh.
2. Jeff Woodbury—gave update of West End Trail Committee. Shared map of the trail system. Committee is very active and moving forward with new projects. May 3 at 4:30 pm at Community Center for next meeting.
3. Tex Haeuser--Elm Street Parking issue—city council approved 120' of NO PARKING on west side of street in order to accommodate firetruck access.
4. Tex Haeuser—Update of Paving list. Working with Water Resource department who is coordinating with public works. There must be coordination with PACTS to determine needs for paving and sidewalk improvement. Committee will invite Brad Weeks of Water Resource to come to our October meeting for fall update.
5. Tex Haeuser—Cottage Road update. City Manager will recommend monies to be allotted to this project. Other money from PACTS. Committee will work with Steve Sawyer of Sebago Technics for final plan for improvements. Clear that “mill and fill” repair on street will be necessary.
6. ACTION ITEM—the Committee reviewed the project on Clark’s Pond Roadway (done by V. Maietta). Committee made following recommendation:
  - a. Alan Mills—Move that the Bike-Ped Committee respectfully recommends to the Planning Board that the applicant be responsible for closing the sidewalk gap along the Parkway (project site to 9 Donald B Dean Drive) and also for providing an easement for non-vehicular public access for the portions of the Clark’s Pond and Red Brook trails that pass through the property. SECOND: Sue Henderson

  - b. Tex will draft recommendation and submit to planning board before next meeting.
