**Wainwright – Rehab Soccer Field**

The Parks, Recreation, and Waterfront Department seeks \$20,000.00 in funds to Rehab a soccer field at the Wainwright Farm Recreation Complex. This field would be used in the Spring by the South Portland Strikers Travel Soccer Organization and in the Summer by the South Portland High School Summer Soccer Programs, as well as South Portland Recreation Soccer Camps. During the fall this field would be the home game field used by the Men’s and Women’s Soccer Programs from Southern Maine Community College.

Southern Maine Community College Athletic Department would provide infrastructure for this field in the way of benches, scorer’s tables, bleachers, and scoreboard (potentially solar powered scoreboard.) Currently, SMCC teams are playing games on the Multi-Purpose Game field at the Wainwright Complex. This has caused a number of scheduling conflicts on this field with the South Portland Youth Football Programs games, South Portland Strikers Soccer Games, and on an adjacent field with South Portland School Athletics Field Hockey Games.

The Rehab of this field space would also help with or organic fields program, as housing the spring and summer programs on this field and not on the fields on the “soccer quad” allows Parks Maintenance staff to use organic practices (aerating, seeding, composting) to prepare the fields for the fall.

Currently this field space is used for overflow of these events, but the field conditions are not conducive to a higher level of athletic events. There is a small slope to one side of the field, patches of bare ground, and ruts and bumps in this area. We recently contracted to have irrigation lines run to this field space in preparation for future use of this space.

The project will include the following work to be done by Sports Turf Specialties, or a like company. Stripping of existing grass and breaking up the thatch layer. Tilling existing soil to eliminate compaction and blend layers leaving homogenous blend of soil to the proper soil depth. Laser grading to level the field to firm up the soil and prep for seed.

Parks staff will purchase seed and composting material and handle the labor of growing and maintaining the grass. If accepted the project is estimated to be completed during the fall of 2018

**John Deere 15 Series 72” Overseeder**

The Parks, Recreation and Waterfront Department seeks \$9,689 in funds to purchase a John Deere 15 Series 72” Overseeder to help supplement the organic growth initiative in Parks and Open Spaces. This machine is an attachment that would fit on our current Kubota tractor, and would be used to spread seed in areas of need. Currently, the department uses a similar piece of equipment that is borrowed from a neighboring town, and is not always readily available when needed.

This Overseeder offers precise placement and seed to soil contact, which makes it ideal for overseeding existing strands of grass or establishing new turf. The three-way seed-to-soil contact system provides great germination and emergence with solid advantages of full-width seeding patterns. The solid, cast-iron packer wheels finish the job by pressing and firmly packing the seed into the soil, eliminating most air pockets.
